FARM WORKERS DEATH

The death occurred on Wednesday week of Mr. **Frederick James COOPER**, aged 70, of Solent View, Windmill Shute, Upton, who started work on the land at the age of 14 and was a farm worker for 50 years. He was nearly 30 years with Mr. H. PLUMBLEY at Kemphill Farm, Upton, and retired in 1944 owing to ill-health. In the first world war he was employed at a Cowes Shipyard.

The funeral took place at All Saints' Church on Saturday, the Rev. P. L. VAUGHAN officiating. The mourners were Mrs. A. COOPER (widow), Mr. and Mrs. A. G. COOPER (son and daughter-in-law), and Miss M. COOPER (daughter). Mr. H. PLUMBLEY represented Kemphill Farm. The interment was at Ashe Cemetery.
