

DEATH OF AN OLD SOLDIER.- The death took place, on the 25th ult., at the age of 77, of Mr **J. H. CRAWFORD**, who was well known in former days in the Island. He served in the 43rd Regiment, and was afterwards sergeant in the 60th Rifles and sergeant in hospital with Miss Nightingale in the Crimea, and afterwards in India, where he remained 25 years. He joined the Army Scripture Readers' Society in India, and returned to Parkhurst with the troops in 1871. For many years past he has been evangelist to the St. John's House Mission, and was much respected.

The funeral took place on the 27th, Pastor A. DEDAMESS performing the service, in the presence of a large number of people, and speaking eloquently of the bright Christian example set by him who was gone.
