A Property Auction ----of business premises and small local properties was held on Monday afternoon at Town-hall Chambers by WALLIS, RIDDETT and Company, incorporated with Henry J. WAY and Son. There was an excellent attendance and Mr. E. P. MARVIN, F.A.I., had 11 lots to dispose of and 10 of these were sold after spirited bidding. No. 55 Union-street, business premises sold by order of the trustee, in bankruptcy £1220.

Seven lots of cottages in Green-street, Mount-street, and Station-street, for the executors of R. R. GRIFFITHS, deceased, realised £200, £280, £510, £200, £120, 200, and £175. The vendors solicitors were Messrs. James ELDRIDGE and Sons of Ryde.

Southwold, a freehold cottage with possession in High Park fetched £600. Mr. C. W. VINCENT, of Ryde, being solicitor for Mr. **DALE**'s executor.

No. 73 Upton-road made £260. Messrs. John ROBINSON and JARVIS, of Ryde, were the solicitors for the owner. Holmwood, Argyll-street, was the only property which did not sell but it has since been disposed of. The total sum realised, £4365 was a very satisfactory result.
