Former Schoolmaster's Death.---The death occurred on Sunday in a local nursing home of Mr. Frank Jonathan DALE, of Southwold, High Park-road, aged 74. He was for several years a member of the teaching staff at the Upper Grade School and subsequently removed to St. Helens, where for 22 years he was head master of the C.E. Boys' School, retiring 17 years ago. A native of Stisted, Essex, he was educated at Peterborough and came to Ryde as a teacher at the age of 22. Ill-health resulted in his retirement at an early age and had since limited his activities. He was, however, able to take an interest in St. John's Church, where he was a member of the Council and a sidesman. Some years ago he was a member of Holy Trinity church choir. His garden was his hobby. His wife died 18 months ago and he leaves a sister. He was much esteemed and the news of his death has been received with regret, especially among his old scholars.

The funeral took place in St. John's Church on Tuesday, when the service was conducted by the Rev. E. T. H. ROYDS. The mourners were Miss DALE (sister), Miss HAWKINS, and Mr. A. W. ROLLOSON. There was a large congregation. The interment was beside his wife in Ryde Cemetery and the flowers included a wreath from the Vicar, officials, and Church Council of St. John's.
