DEATH OF MRS DAWSON

The death took place on Thursday at Wilton Grange, Ashey-road, of Mrs. **Lucy Alleyne DAWSON**, widow of Col. H. C. DAWSON, of Lawnd Abbey, Leicestershire. The deceased had been associated with Ryde for about 30 years. Her husband, who was a member of the Royal Victoria Y.C., predeceased her in 1928, and her only son, Capt. Herbert E. DAWSON, the Lincolnshire Regiment, was killed in the first retreat from Mons in 1914. She was the daughter of Mr. Gerald HIGGINS, of Lancashire. Mrs. DAWSON was a member of the women's section of the British Legion and did much to alleviate suffering among ex-Servicemen. She was one of the oldest members of the Ryde Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club.

The funeral will take place today (Saturday) at St. Michael's Church at 2 p.m.
