**Elderly Lady's Death Follows Fall.** - The Coroner (Mr. R.E.A. WEBSTER) held an inquest on Monday on Mrs. **Grace DIXON**, aged 86, who died on Friday week at 1 Clyde House, Dover Street, following an accidental fall early in June. Police Inspector F. RUGMAN was present. Dr. L.P.L. FIRMAN-EDWARDS said that on June 8<sup>th</sup> he was called to see Mrs. DIXON, who had fallen and fractured the neck of the right femur. Her condition gradually deteriorated, and she died on Friday week of general exhaustion due to the senile decay, accelerated by the effects of the fracture. The Coroner recorded a verdict of death from natural causes. Mrs. DIXON was the widow of Mr. Alfred DIXON, a retired manufacturer, who died on March 3<sup>rd</sup>.
