MRS. J. R. DIXON

The death occurred last week after a long illness of Mrs. **Annie DIXON**, the wife of Mr. J.R. DIXON, of Ravenswood, High-Park, Ryde.

Mrs. DIXON was a daughter of the late Mr. Joseph JAMES, the principal of the firm of cycle makers, of Cheltenham, and was the first lady to ride a cycle in that town. In her youth she was a hockey player and a skater of some merit. She has lived in Ryde for 36 years.

Her husband is the former headmaster of Oakfield Boys' School, and during his scholastic career Mrs. DIXON was his keen assistant and was prominent in the organisation of school concerts and other functions. Besides the husband two daughters are left.

The funeral at St. John's Church on Saturday was conducted by the Rev. R.T.H. ROYDS. The family mourners were Mr. DIXON (husband), Mr. and Mrs. S.G. BARNETT (son-in-law and daughter), Miss R. DIXON (daughter), Miss L. VALE (companion), and Mrs. MIDWAY (nurse). Among the wreaths was one from the Town Club.
