The death took place at Kennet Lodge, Simeon-street, on Tuesday, of Mr. **William G. DOWNER**. The deceased who was 49, was employed at Eastman's local branch for many years prior to the war, during which he saw service in Mesopotamia and on the Western Front, where he was badly gassed, and had suffered ill-health in consequence. His brother, Mr. E. DOWNER, who was also gassed in the war, died two years ago.

The funeral will be on Monday, the first part of the service at Holy Trinity Church, in which deceased was formerly a choir boy.

NB: We have noted a discrepancy in the name, it should be William O. DOWNER (not 'G')
