Death of Miss F. M. DRAWBRIDGE.- The funeral took place on Saturday at the Parish Church of Miss Florence Maud DRAWBRIDGE, 84, of Woodlands, Quarr Road, who died in a local nursing home on Wednesday week. A native of Scarborough, she was the daughter of the late Mr. William DRAWBRIDGE, senior partner in the firm of Messrs. MEDLEY, DRAWBRIDGE and Co., of Scarborough. She came to the Island in 1917 and lived at Havenstreet with her brother, Mr. C. V. DRAWBRIDGE, who died in 1940. During both wars Miss DRAWBRIDGE was an active worker for the British Red Cross Society. She was also a devoted member of the Parish Church.

The service was conducted by the Rector (the Rev. H. N. WRIGLEY). The mourners were Cmdr. W. N. DRAWBRIDGE and Mr. C. B. DRAWBRIDGE (nephews) and Mrs. E. M. ASHE (niece). Mrs. C. B. DRAWBRIDGE was unable to attend. The burial was at Binstead Cemetery.
