MRS. E. E. DRIVER

The death occurred on Sunday last of Mrs. **Elizabeth Emily DRIVER** of 19, Monkton Street, Ryde, at the age of 80. Mrs. DRIVER, a native of Ryde, was the eldest daughter of Mr. Frederick FEBEN, and loved all her life in the district, where her quiet personality won her a wide circle of friends. She married in 1878 and her husband pre-deceased her 9 years since. Eight of her nine children are living. A son, Mr. Reginald Victor DRIVER, was killed in Egypt while serving with the Isle of Wight Rifles during the War .

The funeral took place on Thursday at All Saints Parish Church, the Rev. E. J. FORSR officiating. The personal mourners were Messrs. S. H. and J. D. DRIVER (sons), Mesdames L. CARRAHER, E.
