Death of Mrs. EDWARDS.- We regret to announce the death suddenly from heart trouble on Tuesday at 42 Melville-street of Mrs. Amy Frances EDWARDS, mother of Dr. L. Firman EDWARDS, of Kent Lodge. Until three weeks ago, when she removed to Ryde, Mrs. EDWARDS had lived for about 18 years at 3, Carlton, Queens'-road, Cowes, where she was held in much esteem. She actively associated herself with Holy Trinity Church, Cowes, being a district visitor and doing much charitable work until her health failed a few years since. She was born in 1866 at Hatfield Broadoak, Essex, and was a daughter of the late Dr. Charles FIRMAN. Sincere sympathy has been extended to Dr. Firman EDWARDS in his sudden bereavement.

The coffin was taken to Holy Trinity Church on Thursday and Vespers of the Dead were said. The Rev. L. N. ST. ALPHONSE (vicar) was the celebrant at a requiem mass yesterday (Friday) and conducted the funeral service in the afternoon. The mourners were Dr. and Mrs. L. Firman EDWARDS (son and daughter-in-law), Miss Ruth Firman EDWARDS (grand-daughter), and Mrs. ANDERSON. Several friends attended. The interment was in Ryde Cemetery.
