BINSTEAD Farmers Sudden Death

The death occurred suddenly on Saturday of Mr. **Henry Alfred FLEMING**, aged 64, of Quarr Farm. He was taken ill while putting his cows out to pasture the previous day. JAMES (sister), and Mr. and Mrs. J. WALTON (brother-in-law and sister).
