30/7/1853 .. 1st prize--red currants, gooseberries, raspberries, cherries, round potatoes; 2nd prize-beet; 3rd prize cabbage, peas, broad beans (In the grounds at St. Clare)

17/9/1853 .. 2nd prize--raspberries, plums, round potatoes; 3rd prize--apples, beet root. (in the little grounds of H. W. Nunn, Esq., Broadlands, Newport)

24/6/1854.. of Woodlands - 1st prize--dish of cherries, dish of strawberries, dish of red currants, round potatoes; 2nd prize--6 carrots; 3rd prize--12 onions; Extra prize--3 lettuces. (In the grounds of Capt. and Mrs. Beckford at Buckingham Villa)

28/7/1855 .. 1st prize--dish of red currants, and a curiosity, Chinese pea; 2nd prize--dish of cherries, dish of white currants, dish of gooseberries, and carrots; 3rd prize--dish of strawberries and dish of raspberries; extra prize--beetroot, onions, and kidney potatoes. (In the grounds of Sir William Martin, Westmont)

23/8/1856 .. 1st prize--12 plums, dish of red currants and a dish or white currants; 2nd prize--brace of cucumbers, 12 round potatoes and 12 kidney potatoes. 3rd prize--round potatoes; Extra prize-kidney potatoes. (In the grounds of Dr. Leeson at Bonchurch)

21/8/1858 .. 1st prize--dish of red currants, dish of raspberries, brace of cucumbers; 2nd--dish of white currants, dish of gooseberries, 12 plums, 12 green gages, dish of black currants; 3rd--12 kidney potatoes; extra--12 apples. (In the grounds at Westfield)

20/8/1859 .. 1st prize--white currants, black currants, and apples; 2nd prize--red currants; 3rd prize--green gages, plums, and gooseberries; Extra--kidney potatoes, and round potatoes, and cucumbers. (In the grounds of Sir Augustus Clifford at Westfield)

11/8/1860 .. 1st prize--red currants, cucumbers; 2nd prize--white currants, black currants; 3rd prize-raspberries; Extra--broad beans, round potatoes. (In the grounds of Col. Harcourt at St. Clare)

29/6/1861 .. 1st prize--round potatoes; 2nd prize--strawberries and red currants; 3rd prize--white currants, lettuce, and herbs; Extra--cherries, black currants, and cabbage. (In the grounds of George Young esq., known as Apley Towers)

28/6/1862 .. 1st prize--cherries, strawberries, currants, round potatoes; 2nd prize--broad beans; 3rd prize--peas; Extra--onions. (In the grounds of John Fleming at Binstead)

20/8/1864 .. 1st prize--black currants, white currants, vegetable marrows; 3rd prize--round potatoes; Extra--apples, red currants (by permission of Geo Young in the grounds of Apley Towers)

24/6/1865 .. 1st prize--black currants, red currants, gooseberries, herbs; 2nd prize--lettuce, cherries, strawberries, white currants, raspberries, broad beans. (by permission of Rev. W. H. Girdlestone in the grounds of Gwydyr House)

19/8/1865 .. 1st prize--green gages, red and white currants, herbs, beet root, onions; 2nd prize--

black currants, desert apples, lettuce; 3rd prize--potatoes. (by permission of Sir. A. Clifford, bart. In the grounds of Westfield)

23/6/1866 .. 1st prize--12 onions, dish of cherries, herbs; 2nd prize--3 lettuces, 3 cabbages; 3rd prize--50 broad beans. (by permission of James Hyde, esq., in his grounds at Apley)

20/6/1868 .. 1st prize--cherries, white currants, black currants, raspberries, gooseberries, and cabbage; 2nd prize--red currants and sweet herbs. (In the ground of W. Hyde, esq., at Apley)
