*In 1911 **Albert GALE** (42) was living at Wilmington, Oakfield Hill, Ryde, with his wife Florence (38), 2 sons Alfred (18) & Reginald (12), 2 daughters Winifred (15) & Queenie (5), and his father-in-law Alfred MORRIS (78) and his brother-in-law Leslie MORRIS (33). **Albert** was listed as a Butcher (employer at home).*

Death of Mr. A. J. GALE.- The death took place at a nursing home on Wednesday of Mr. Albert John GALE, of St. Just, Ratcliffe-avenue, in his 72nd year. Deceased was formerly in business as a butcher at St. John's-hill, and until health failed three months ago was a regular attendant at Newport Market, where he had been a familiar figure all his life. For many years he had been associated with the High-street Methodist Church and at the time of his death was its treasurer.
