DEATH OF MISS GOODE.---We regret to announce the death of Miss GOODE, which took place at Cumberland House, St. Thomas-street, on Thursday of last week at the age of 71 yesrs. The deceased lady was very charitable, and will be greatly missed in the town.

The funeral took place on Saturday, the first portion of the service being held at Holy Trinity Church, the Vicar (the Rev J. E. EDDIS) officiating. The service was choral, the hymns "On the Resurrection morning" and "Abide with me" being sung by the choir. The interment took place in the family vault at Binstead Cemetery, the Rector (the Rev. George DAVEY) officiating. The coffin was of polished oak, with heavy brass mountings, and the name-plate bore the following inscription: "Margaret Hodson GOODE, died April 2nd, 1908." There was a large number of floral tributes. Amongst those present in the church were Capt. GOODE, Miss GOODE, Mr. Winter GOODE, Dr. BUCK and Mr. C. G. VINCENT.
