The death of Dr. **Frederick Joseph GREENING**, a well-known and greatly respected medical practioner of the town, occurred at his residence, Melville House, Melville-street, on Monday evening.

DEATH OF DR. GREENING

It is with the deepest regret that we record the death of Dr. **Frederick Joseph GREENING**, M.R.C.S., which occurred at his residence, Melville House, Melville-street, on Monday.

The deceased gentleman who was in his 75th year, came to reside at Ryde a great many years since. He was formerly house surgeon at the County Hospital, then known as the Isle of Wight Infirmary. Mr. GREENING afterwards acquired a practice, which however, he had to relinquish some time ago owing to failing health. He took no prominent part in the affairs of the town, although he was well-known professionally.
