A SAD COINCIDENCE.---Particularly sad are the circumstances associated with the deaths of two neighbours who passed away within a few short hours of each other. Mrs. Delilah Jane GREGORY, of 5 Oakfield-hill, had been in the habit of visiting Mrs. Elizabeth FRAMPTON, who lived a few doors away at 3 Meader's-road, and had been lain aside by illness for some months. On Friday evening she went to the house, and on arrival inside collapsed and died almost immediately. The next day Mrs. FRAMPTON also passed away.

Mrs. GREGORY, who was 60 years of age, had been a member of the Salvation Army for about 40 years, and was one of the pioneers in the establishment of a branch of the Army in the Oakfield district. She was beloved by many of the poorer class for her devotional labours and many little kindnesses. She leaves a crippled husband and grown-up family of eight, several of her six sons being in the Navy.

The funeral took place on Wednesday, the body being taken to the Salvation Army-hall in Green-street, where a short but largely attended service in accordance with the Salvation Army custom was held prior to the interment in the Cemetery.

Mrs. FRAMPTON, who was the widow of Nicholas FRAMPTON, and was aged 85, left one son. Her funeral also took place on Wednesday immediately after that of her neighbour, the interment being at the Ryde Cemetery, where the Rev. J. GILLSON GILL (vicar of St. John's) officiated.
