In 1911 Jane OLD Aged 43. Widow. was a Servant. Born. Kilndown, Kent.  
for a family at 7 Pellhurst Rd, Ryde. IW.

Living at 18 Player Street, Ryde, IW. in 1911. Walter Gregory. Head. Widower. Brick Layer. aged 57. Born Ryde IW.  
living with him were his nine children aged 24 to two years old, Walter was having a hard time after his wife died. A  
Salvation Army lady named Delilah Jane OLD visited him on several occasions, his life was transformed through the  
Salvation Army, he became the Standard Bearer and lead the Ryde Salvation Army Band. [I have a photo of him]

Delilah Jane's son Frederick John OLD went to Australia and married Louisa May MAHOMET there in 1924, Louisa  
May Mahomet was Born 12th May 1901 in Wells-Next-Sea, Norfolk, England. A daughter was born in Adelaide  
Australia. Frederick & Louisa May and child. Departed from Sydney, Australia. Arriving 20 Mar 1927 London, on the  
passenger list he a tailor and going to 5 Oakfield Hill Ryde IW. A son was born in the UK. They were members of the  
Salvation Amy.

There is a report on the death Delilah Jane GREGORY in the County Press, Saturday 4 December 1927 pg 7, she died  
suddenly while visiting a neighbour, on 26 November 1927, and was buried on the 1st of December. see attached.  
Her husband, Walter "Walt" (William Alfred) GREGORY died on 25th Nov 1942 at Forest House, Newport, after living  
at 35 Green Street Ryde for some time.
