Sad Death of a Young Wife.---Much regret and sympathy has been occasioned here by the somewhat sudden death of Mrs. GRIMES, the wife of our young townsman, Mr. T. E. GRIMES. The deceased, who was married on the 26th December last, was the youngest daughter of Mr. John MEADER, builder, of Ryde, and went with her husband to reside at Merthyr Tydvil, South Wales, where she died, after a short illness, on the 8th inst.

We regret to learn also that the sister of the deceased, Mrs. KING, of the High-street, went to nurse her sister and contracted a very serious illness while there, and at one time her life was despaired of, although we now hear she is out of danger.

We need hardly say that both the families of Mr. MEADER and Mr. KING have the general sympathy of their neighbours in their troubles.

The remains of Mrs. GRIMES were brought to Ryde and interred in the cemetery on Tuesday afternoon.
