

H.M.S. BROKE

HMS Broke was built by the J S White shipyard for the Chilean Navy.

The contract to build 4 destroyers was changed to allow the Royal Navy to take command of the ships on completion.

The Alimirante Goni became the Broke.

The Alimirante Simpson became the Faulknor.

The Alimirante W. Robellido became the Botha.

The Alimirante Riveres became the Tipperary.

All were to see action at Jutland on 31.5.16.

Tipperary sadly sunk after sustaining an uncontrollable fire aboard.

Broke received many hits in the battle and had many of her crew killed.

When repairs had been completed she joined Faulknor and Botha on the Dover Patrol.

After the war the 3 ships were delivered to the Chilean navy
