## THE LATE MR. F. HALSTED

The death occurred on Friday week of Mr. **Frederick HALSTED**, of 21 Millward-road. Mr. HALSTED, who was 93, was born in the borough, and in 1889 at the age of 27, took part in Ryde's first carnival. He lived for 38 years in Millward-road and previously in Cross-street, and he was a watchmaker and jeweller.
