Additional Information contributed by Kurt Ganzl from New Zealand in September 2011, Kurt is an author and writes about the history of music:

"She was born **Kate Harpur Bennett** on 15 September 1837 to James Bennett and his wife Matilda nee Brown. James (1801-1870) was a well-known tenor singer. Kate married 13 October 1860 Frederick Theodor Gottlieb Jensen, a Norwegian artist who spent some time in Engand in the 1850s and early 1860s, before continuing to India. He has a place in the history of Indian art as ... a bad, old fashioned influence! He was apparently not a very inspired artist who made his living chasing commissions to paint portraits of royalty etc (he painted the Prince and Princess of Wales)

I don't know where life took them, after India. But he survived until the 1890s and the much younger Kate of course longer."
