**DEATH OF MRS. JACKSON.**- The death took place at 23 Surrey-street on Sunday of Mrs. Ada JACKSON, wife of Mr. T. H. Scott JACKSON. The deceased, who had been in failing health for some time, was 67 years of age. She leaves a husband and 10 grown up sons and daughters.

The funeral was on Wednesday, the first part of the service being held in Holy Trinity Church, where her husband has been a sidesman for between 40 and 50 years. The Vicar (the Rev. S. A. MARSH) officiated. Mr. A. P. JAMES was at the organ and played "Blest are the departed" as the coffin was taken into the church and "O rest in the Lord" as the cortege left. The hymn "Rock of ages" was sung. The mourners were Mr. T. H. Scott JACKSON (husband), Mrs. GUY, Mrs. W. G. TILL, and Mrs. DUNFORD (daughters), Messrs. William, Percy, Reginald, Arthur, Edward, and Alfred Scott JACKSON (sons), Mrs. LONG and Mrs. JAMES (sisters), Messrs. F. DUNFORD and G. GUY (sons-in-law), Mrs. COX and daughter and Mrs. SMITH (sisters-in-law). Deceased's eldest

son, Mr. Thomas Scott JACKSON, who is in Canada, and Mr. W. G. TILL (son-in-law) were unable to be present. The Rev. C. E. TOOTH, curate of Holy Trinity, officiated at the grave. A large collection of flowers included a floral tribute from the Holy Trinity Social Club.
