*It was opened by William Gardner in the mid 1830's and first called The Harlequin. He renamed it
The Nelson Tavern in 1857. Ownership changed to John Dive by 1875, and then to William Coggin*

by 1878 who renamed it The Nelson Hotel. It was auctioned in 1885 and closed its doors as licensed premises.

The Nelson Tavern from W. Gardner (landlord 24 years) to William Jenkins.

Isle of Wight Observer 11 June 1881

The Nelson Hotel from Joan Hunt to Frederick Umhauer.
