Mr. C. G. KELLEWAY

It is with regret that we record the death of Mr. **Charles George KELLEWAY** (79), which occurred at his residence, 20, Cross-Street, Eastfield, rather suddenly on Saturday afternoon. He was formerly a platelayer on the Isle of Wight Railway for 33 years, but retired when the Island lines were amalgamated with the Southern Railway in 1921. He at one time worshipped at the ex-Primitive Methodist Chapel at Oakfield.

The funeral took place (Wednesday) afternoon at the Ryde Cemetery Chapel when the Vicar of St. John's (the Rev. J. Gillson GILL officiated.
