Death of Mrs. M.C. KINGMAN. - The death occurred at a local nursing home on Saturday of Mrs. Mabel Catherine KINGMAN, of 4 Benett Street, aged 66. She was the widow of Mr. J.J. KINGMAN, who died in 1937, and her younger son was killed while serving with the R.A.F. in the last war. She was a member of the Afternoon Townswomen's Guild.
