SUDDEN DEATH

We have to record the death of Mr. **R. KITSON**, of Warwick-place, which occurred this (Friday) morning. It appears that the deceased had complained of being unwell the day before, something he had eaten having disagreed with him. On retiring to rest he complained to his wife that he felt severe pain in the chest. The next morning early she got up and slipped down stairs to get him a cup of tea, and did not disturb him, thinking him asleep. On bringing him some breakfast she found he was dead. An inquest will be held.

Mr. KITSON had been a warder in some of H.M. prisons, and a few weeks ago we published a number of interesting verses which he had copied from prisoners' slates while he was in H.M. service.
