Mrs. LANE, Cemetery-road, Binstead, has heard that her husband, Corpl. **W. J. LANE**, was killed in action at Gaza. Corpl. LANE, who has lived at Binstead for a number of years, was a thorough sportsman, and was for a considerable time a playing member of the Football club. He was one of the first of the men in the village to join the colours in August 1914, enlisting in the I.W. Rifles, in which he was serving when he was killed. Prior to enlisting he was employed by Messrs. Randall & Co. He leaves a widow and one son.
