MEMORIAL TO THE LATE MRS. LEEDS.

A memorial to the late Mrs. Augustus F. LEEDS was unveiled at Holy Trinity Church, on Friday, the 8th inst. The service was the order for Holy Communion with the addition of some special prayers and hymns 537 and 140. The service was taken by the Rev. H.B. BREW, M.A., who was the celebrant. The memorial was unveiled by the Rev W.F.J. HANBURY, of Swanmore. The memorial, which was executed by Messrs BONHAM and FROUD, is a large Verde antique marble slab, on which is a marble cross, carrying a polished brass cross. Beneath is a brass plate similarly mounted on which, carved in relief, is the following inscription :

"To the Glory of God, and in ever loving

Memory of Anna Maria Frances LEEDS who passed away Sept. 8th, 1904. Requiescat in Pace."
