Mrs. K. M. LLOYD. – The death occurred on Thursday of Mrs Kathleen Mary LLOYD, wife of Mr. T. A. LLOYD of Flat "A", Perivale, Playstreet Lane. She was 70. The only child of a former "I.W. County Press" editor, Mr W. H. DANN, she was born in Ryde, and she had lived both here and in the Newport area. After being educated at Westwing Girl's School, she trained as a pupil teacher at Newport Secondary School and her subsequent teaching career was largely as a private tutor. Among her appointments was governess to the daughters of the governor of Parkhurst Prison in 1917, and she also coached the daughters of officers at Albany Barracks, and girls connected with Island families, her special subjects including English. Latin and French. She was married in 1931 when living at Newport. In 1941 Mrs LLOYD returned to her old school, Westwing, as a teacher, retiring on the death of Miss BARTON, the principle. She then resumed private tuition, coaching both foreign and English students, and for the past five years had been connected with the Organisation Scolaire Franco-Britannique.

Mrs. LLOYD had for many years been associated with All Saints' Parish Church, Ryde, where the funeral service took place on Monday, conducted by the Rev George RUMBLE. Interment was at Ryde Cemetery.
