**RYDE TRADESMAN'S DEATH**

The death occurred yesterday (Friday) at a nursing home of Mr. **Reginald LONG**, of 9 Partlands Avenue, Ryde, a well-known local tradesman. Mr. LONG had been in failing health since January, but recently his illness had seriously developed, the end coming rather suddenly. The deceased carried on business in the old-established outfitter's and tailor's shop in Cross-street, succeeding his father, and was well-known in sporting circles in the town. For some years and until recently he was hon treasurer of Ryde Sports Club, a former member of the Rowing Club, and a prominent Freemason. Deep sympathy will be felt with the widow, son, and daughter in their sad bereavement.
