THE WILL OF THE LATE SIR JOHN MACGREGOR.- The will of the late Sir John MACGREGOR, M.D., K.C.B., Inspector General of Hospitals, formerly of Upper Hamilton Terrace, St. John's-wood, and late of Corstorphine Lodge, Ryde, Isle of Wight, was proved in London under £14,000 personalty by his relict, Lady MACGREGOR; his son, James Duncan MACGREGOR, 78th Highlanders, and Frederick Halsey JANSON, esq., the joint acting executors. The will is dated Oct. 6, 1863, and a codical Jan 8, 1866. This distinguished military surgeon and physician died Jan. 13, at Corstorphine Lodge, Ryde, at the age of 75. To Lady MACGREGOR he leaves all his wines and consumable stores absolutely, and the use of his furniture, books, musical instruments, plate, and all other household effects, and an annuity of £150. The furniture at her decease is to be divided amongst his three daughters, Jessie, Flora, and Ellen, and the residue of his property also amongst them in equal shares. - *Illustrated London News*.
