DEATH OF CAPT. W. F. MARRIOTT.---Ryde loses another old and esteemed resident by the death on Tuesday at his residence, 10 Barfield, of Capt. William Frederick MARRIOTT. He was born at Kings Lynn, Norfolk, on March 22nd 1848, and was the son of the late Mr. Thomas

Batman MARRIOTT, and grandson of the Rev. Robert MARRIOTT, fellow of Gonville and Caiun College, Cambridge, and rector of Broadway with Bincombe, Dorset. He was educated at Norwich Grammar School, entered the Army at an early age, and saw services with the 83rd (Dublin) Regiment at Gibralter and in India. On being invalid home he was transferred to the 41st Welsh Regiment, and later to the 66th Berkshire Regiment. On retiring in 1886 Capt. MARRIOTT came to live at Ryde for a time. For 13 years he resided at Shanklin and then left the Island for a short period before returning to Ryde, where he had since resided. He had been a member of the Royal Victoria Yacht Club for over 40 years. Mrs. MARRIOTT predeceased him three years ago. They had five daughters.

The Rev. W. N. MARTIN (vicar) conducted the funeral at the Parish Church yesterday (Friday). The mourners were the Misses Mabel, Margaret, Nora, and Kathleen MARRIOTT (daughters), Mr. C. J. B. MARRIOTT and Miss PROWSE (cousins). There were also present Dr. D. J. DAVIES, Miss LANE, Miss MAY, Mr. And Mrs. PELHAM-CLAY, Mr. R. BLECHYNDEN, Mrs. S. A. MARSH, Miss ANSTEY, Miss PRICE, Nurse WHEELER, Mr. C. H. DAISH (gardener), Miss VINCENT, Miss and Miss M. FISHER, and Miss JOY.

The Nunc Dimittis was chanted and Mr. E. G. WELSH was at the organ. The interment was at the Cemetery and the grave was covered with several choice wreaths.
