DEATH OF AN OLD RESIDENT.- The death took place at Buckingham-road on August 21st of Mr. Joseph MARSH, at the age of 87. The deceased could remember the knell tolling on the occasion of the death of King William IV. He did some of the decorations of the state apartments at Osborne for Queen Victoria and the Prince Consort.

The funeral took place at the Cemetery on Thursday of last week, the Rev. Hugh LE FLEMING (vicar) officiating. The mourners were Miss MARSH (daughter), Mr. JOLLIFFE (nephew), Miss SIVELL (sister-in-law), Mrs. SPRAGG (niece), and Mr. S. COOPER.
