Isle of Wight Times 24th Aug 1916

2nd Lieut. W. J. McLean, 1st Essex Regiment, late 2nd Hants Regiment, died of wounds on August 12. He was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. Peter McLean, 27 Albert Street, and had seen about 17 years service, first in the 2nd Hants and during the last three years in the 1st Essex Regiment. He was promoted to the rank of 2nd Lieut. in June last for service in the field. Very much sympathy is felt with the bereaved parents. Lieut. McLean was unmarried. In a letter to the deceased officer's parents, under date of August 12th his Colonel says: "I very much regret to have to inform you that your son died of wounds this morning. He was out with a wiring party when he received a bullet through the stomach. The doctor attended to him at once and he was taken to the field ambulance but the wounds proved fatal shortly after. I very much regret his loss as he was very valuable to me, being an old soldier and knowing his work well. Please accept my deepest sympathy."
