**DEATH OF MR. J. W. MEADER.**—The death occurred at 7 King's-road on Friday week, after a long illness, of Mr. James William MEADER, aged 69. Mr. MEADER was an ex-sergeant of the Royal Engineers, and saw 21 years 'service, retiring shortly before the war.
