## LOCAL PREACHER'S DEATH.

Island Methodism has lost a valued worker by the death on Sunday of Mr. Frank MILLER, aged 75, of 10 Millward-Road. Mr. MILLER, a Londoner, served in the Middle East during the 1914-18 war he came to live with his wife and family at Binstead in 1921. in 1928 they moved here.
