### **MRS. E. MORRIS**

Mrs. Ellen MORRIS, of 11 Well Street, who would have celebrated the 72nd anniversary of her wedding day next month, died at her residence on Tuesday, aged 92. Mrs. MORRIS was born at Ryde and was married at Newchurch. Her husband, Mr. George MORRIS still survives and enjoys good health despite his 92 years. After the celebration of their 68th anniversary of their wedding the

old couple received a letter from the King and Queen conveying their Majesties' hearty congratulations and sincere good wishes, and also a congratulatory message from the Ryde Town Council. Mrs. MORRIS, who had lived at her residence in Well Street for 43 years, died of shock following a fall which took place six weeks ago. She had only been confined to her bed for a week, however.

The funeral took place on Saturday afternoon at the Cemetery when the Rev. C. E. TOOTH (Curate at Holy Trinity) officiated, the mourners being Mr. H. MORRIS, of Southampton (son), Miss K. MORRIS, Mrs. R. MORRIS, of London, Mrs. WATSON, of Petersfield, and Miss Eva MORRIS, of Windsor (daughters), Mr. F. CLEMENTS, of Cowes (son-in-law), and Mr. W. CLEMENTS (grandson).
