Death of Mrs. D.M. NORRIE, - The death occurred in hospital on Friday week of Mrs. Doris May NORRIE, aged 53, of 4 St. Michael's Avenue. A native of Swanmore, she lived there all her life and spent the last 35 years in the same house. She married Mr. R.J. NORRIE in 1942. Mrs. NORRIE was Methodist and worshipped at the Garfield Road church. She was well known in the town and for 12 years she worked at Messrs.
