**RYDE'S OLDEST ROMAN CATHOLIC DIES AGED 82**  
**MR. J. OSMOND**

The death occurred at St. Mary's Hospital, Newport, on Thursday of a former Ryde tailor Mr. James OSMOND, a bachelor, of 18 Surrey Street, Ryde. He was 82.

A native of Ryde, Mr. OSMOND was the oldest member of St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church, Ryde. He had lived at Surrey Street for more than 50 years. Ill health forced him to retire from the tailoring trade about 12 years ago. His main interest, apart from the Church, was in reading.

The deceased lay in St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church overnight on Sunday, and a Requiem Mass was conducted on Monday morning by Father J. TROY and Father D. MCDERMOTT-ROE. The mourners were: Mr. and Mrs. C. WHITE, Mrs. P. BIGGS and Miss E. MATTHEWS. Interment followed at Ryde Cemetery.
