DEATH OF MRS. PARSONS. - We regret to record the death of Mrs. **G.A. PARSONS**, widow of the late Captain PARSONS, of Holly Mount, West Street. The deceased lady came to Ryde on a visit to Madam POCLET, Barfield House, last week, and contracted a chill on the journey, and died on Sunday.

The funeral took place on Wednesday last, at Ryde Cemetery, when the deceased lady was interred in the same grave as the late Captain PARSONS. The coffin was of polished elm with brass fittings, with plate engraved, "Georgeanna PARSONS, entered into rest July 16th, 1899, aged 58 years." The mourners were Mr and Mrs RYSE (daughter) Mrs SHIEL (sister), General GRANT, Mr VINCENT, Rev. STREATFIELD, Madam POCLET, Dr. DAVEY, Miss WATKINS. The Rev. HAMILTON, assisted by the Rev. HOSGOOD (late curate of St. Thomas's church) officiated.
