Mrs. A. M. PHILLIPS. – Widow of Mr. Henry PHILLIPS, who was for 49 years station foreman at St. John's Road Station, Mrs. Alice Mary PHILLIPS died at St. Mary's Hospital, Newport on Saturday aged 87. Mrs. PHILLIPS had since 1959 been a resident at Polars Guest House. A life-long Methodist, she was at one time a member of Garfield Road Methodist Women's Guild. She was married in 1899 and Mr. PHILLIPS died in 1949, shortly after the couple had celebrated their golden wedding. She leaves a married son and grandson.

The funeral took place yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon at Garfield Road Methodist Church when the service was conducted by the Minister, the Rev. Edgar RICHARDS. The family mourners were: Mr. and Mrs. H. R. PHILLIPS, son and daughter-in-law; Mr. and Mrs. C. CHIVERTON, brother and sister-in-law and Mr. G. PETTY, brother-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. H. R. PHILLIPS were also representing their son Ronald at present serving with R.A.F. in Malta. The funeral was followed by interment in the family grave at Ryde Cemetery.
