The death occurred on Friday, at 16 Simeon-Street, of Mrs. **Sarah Jessie PINDER**, aged 81 years. She was the wife of Mr. T. PINDER, and her daughter Miss Bertha PINDER, was formerly headmistress of Gassiot Girls School, Oakfield. A native of Lincolnshire, Mrs. PINDER came to the Island with her husband in 1930. Mrs. PINDER suffered intensely before her death, but when she was in good health she was a regular worshipper at the Congregational Church. She is survived by a widower, a daughter and two sisters.
