DEATH OF SAPPER G. H. PRICE

Sapper **George Henry PRICE**, R.E., the eldest son of Bdr. And Mrs. C. PRICE, OF 1 Southfield Terrace, Bettesworth-Road, Ryde, was accidentally killed last week four days after returning from leave. PRICE who was 20, was a member of a Territorial R.A. Battery before the war and was well known by many in Ryde.

The funeral took place on Saturday at St. Michael's Swanmore, with full military honours. The Rev. A.C. DURHAM officiated. The Vicar accompanying the hymn "Jesus Lover of my soul" at the organ. The coffin was draped with the Union Jack, and borne by soldiers of a famous regiment. The interment was at Ashey Cemetery, where an Army bugler sounded the "Last Post" and "Reveille."
