DEATH OF MR. W. E. PRITTY

Well known in Ryde and district between the wars as a shoemaker, Mr. William Ernest PRITTY, of Garden Flat, 24 Monkton-street, Ryde, died in a Middlesex hospital last week. He was 75.

Born in London, Mr. PRITTY was apprenticed in the shoe trade in Surrey. He came to Ryde in 1907 and started in business at 15 Spencer-road, where he worked for over 40 years.

During the Great War he served in the R.M.L.I. and saw action in France. He was a fire watcher in Ryde in the last war.

The funeral service took place yesterday (Wednesday) at Holy Trinity Church, conducted by the Vicar, the Rev. John SHAW, followed by interment at Ryde Cemetery.
