Young Girl's Death.- Much sympathy is felt with Mr. and Mrs. Thomas PULLIN, of 73 High-street, in the death on Wednesday week of their five-year-old twin daughter, Daphne Mary Jennet, which took place somewhat suddenly at the County Hospital, following a 12-day illness, during which she suffered much pain, borne with courage and cheerfulness.

The funeral was on Friday, the first part of the service being held at the Parish Church.
