### OBITUARY

The remains of the late Mr. **James RASHLEIGH** were interred at the Cemetery on Monday amidst every manifestation of respectful regret, and an exceptionally large number of floral tributes eloquently testified to the esteem in which he had been held, both by his colleagues at the Lion Brewery---with which he had been identified during practically the whole of his lifetime---and by his fellow townsmen, to whom the unexpected news of his demise had come as a great shock on the preceding Friday.

A service was held at All Saints' Church, the Vicar of Ryde (the Rev. Hugh Le FLEMING, M.A.) subsequently officiating. The mourners included Messrs. H. RASHLEIGH (brother), J.
