Mr. A. H. READ.- The funeral took place at Ryde Cemetery Church on Friday week for Mr. Archibald Henry REED, aged 74, of 10, Argyll Street, who died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital, the previous Monday. Interment followed.

Mr. REED was born in London. During the 1914-18 War he served with the Royal Engineers in Gallipoli and France. In 1929 he moved to the Island and became amusements manager on Shanklin Pier. During the last World War he worked at SAUNDERS-ROE in Cowes. Mr. REED moved to South Africa in 1947 taking up employment with Imperial Cold Storage and later the Aluminium Company. He retired in 1959 and lived in Mossel Bay between Cape Town and Port Elizabeth. He returned to the Island one year ago. Mr. REED leaves a widow and two daughters, one in Cape Town and one in Brisbane, Australia.
