FUNERAL OF THE LATE MRS. R. RUSSELL
Large Gathering at the Parish Church

The funeral of the late Mrs. **Rowland RUSSELL**, whose death was briefly announced in our last issue, took place on Saturday at All Saints Parish Church.

The sincere sorrow which her death has caused amongst all classes of the community was shown by the large gathering at the church and the many tributes sent. Following the hearse was a car completely embowered in wreaths sent by relatives and friends. The Ryde Fire Brigade headed by Chief Officer, Mr. H. JOLLIFFE, formed an escort to the coffin. The service, which was choral, was conducted by the Vicar of Ryde, the Rev. Canon G.A. JOHNSTONE. Mr. P.J. BEVAN was at the organ. The 39th psalm and hymns "Nearer, my God to Thee" and "Peace perfect peace" were sung. As the remains were borne from the church "O rest in the Lord" was played by the organist. The interment took place at Ryde Cemetery.
