### **Tragic Death of Ryde Business Woman**

Mrs. Fanny **SALTER**, widow of Mr. E. **SALTER**, a former member of the Ryde Town Council and a prominent business man, was found dead in a gas-filled box-room at her home, Anglesea Lodge, Buckingham Road, Ryde, on Thursday afternoon.

Mrs. **SALTER**, who was 62, became managing director of Messrs. **BRIGHTON** and **ROGERS**, wholesale confectioners, on the death of her husband. She was a member of the Ryde branch of the Conservative Association and the Townswomen's Guild and a supporter of many charitable causes. Her only child, a daughter, died some years ago.

At the inquest held at the Town Hall yesterday a verdict was returned that the deceased gassed herself in a state of temporary depression, while her mind was unbalanced.
